




Overview

The CIS-80MKV is equipped with 10 x Gigabit Ethernet ports (all ports support Auto MDI/X), an SFP port, and a USB 3.0 port (reserved for future use). It can be powered via the DC jack on the rear (8–38V DC) or via Passive PoE (11–57V DC). With a dual-core ARM processor and 1 GB of RAM, the CIS-80MKV has plenty of power for large homes and light commercial applications.

Powering the Router



Connect the included power supply to the DC jack on the rear of the device, or power via PoE on ETH1



Connect your ISP's modem to the **WAN** port. Connect your laptop or computer to any of the remaining ports.



Configuring the Router


1. Ensure that your computer's IP configuration is set to "Automatically Obtain an IP Address." On OSX, set your Ethernet adapter to "Using DHCP"

2. Obtain the IP Address of the **Default Gateway**. CIS Routers use **10.100.1.1** as the default. You can open a **command prompt** on a Windows machine and enter **ipconfig** to get the default gateway.

3. Open a web browser and navigate to the IP address of your default gateway. The default username is **cis** and the default password is **integration**.





Reset Button

Hold this button while the device is powered off, then apply power. Keeping holding until the USR LED light starts flashing, (5 seconds) then release the button to reset to the default CIS configuration. You can use this procedure if you have forgotten the password to access the device, or simply wish to return the unit to its default configuration state.
